

10 (Courses) to 3 (Years)* Pathway

Description and Purpose:

The 10 Courses to 3 Years* Pathway is designed to provide highly motivated high school students the guidance necessary to complete enough AP, TMU Dual Credit, or other dual credit opportunities that would help students to advance to Thomas More University with almost an entire year's worth of college credit already completed.

*However, while this guide provides a path to complete up to 10 courses (30 credit hours) before attending Thomas More, it may not eliminate time to degree. Certain majors have requirements that will require four or more years of study. Additionally, this pathway does not account for students who may change their majors in college or the exact transferability of specific courses from another institution to TMU. The TMU Dual Credit program also advocates for students to use extra time in college to pursue additional majors/minors, study abroad, and/or gain internship experience.

Below, please find guidance toward completing 10 courses prior to high school graduation in two parts:

- (1) completing core requirements, and
- (2) completing additional core requirements or pursuing a Dual Credit Pathway.

Parts (1) and (2) can be taken concurrently, meaning Part (1) does not need to be completed before a student can begin on Part (2).
