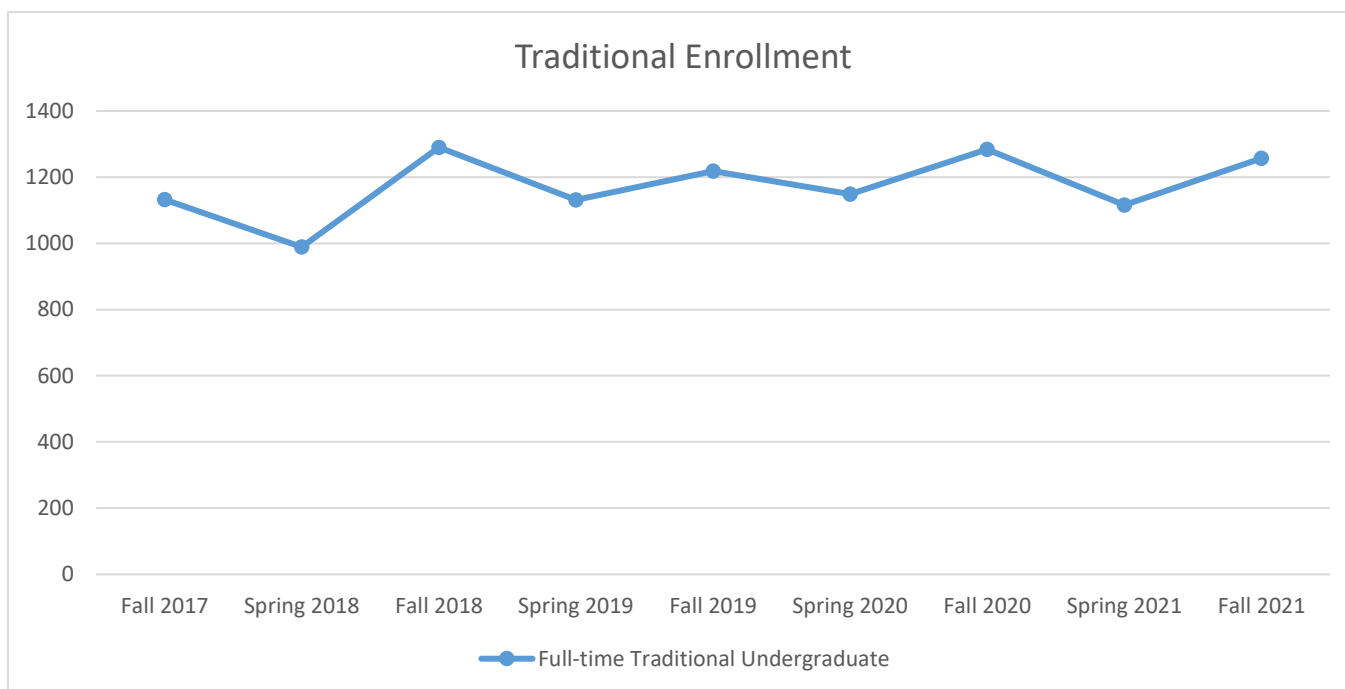
### Executive Summary

Full-time, traditional enrollment is 1,257 students. The final cohort of incoming first-time, full-time students was 388, only slightly below last year's 404. Our spring to fall continuing student persistence rate continues to rise going from 82.8% to 84.2% this fall. Traditional programs with the highest enrollment continue to be Business, Nursing, Biology, and Psychology. Digital, Graduate, and Professional enrollment is 307 students, including 163 undergraduates and 144 graduates. Dual credit enrollment is 388. Finally, the overall student head count is 1,986 students.

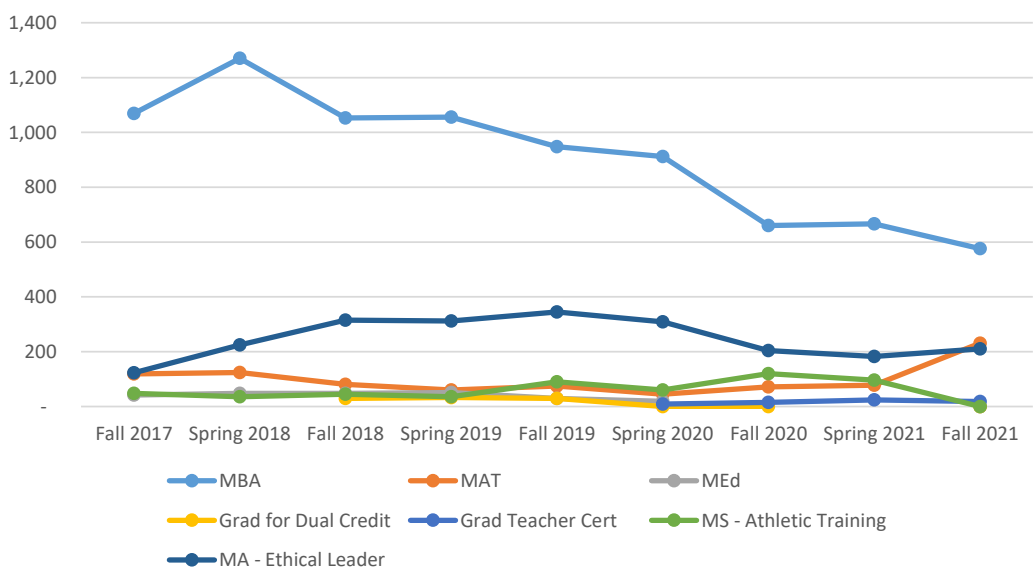

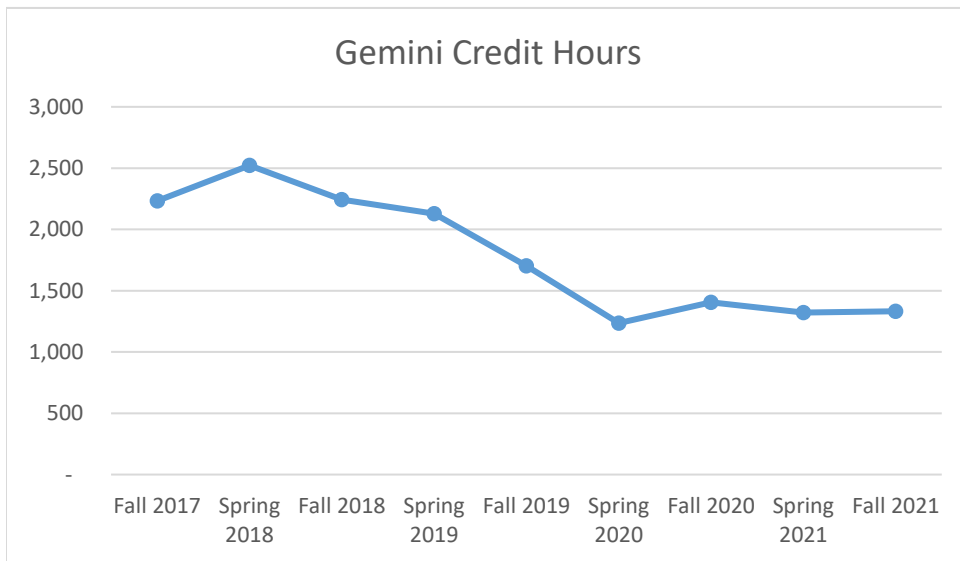
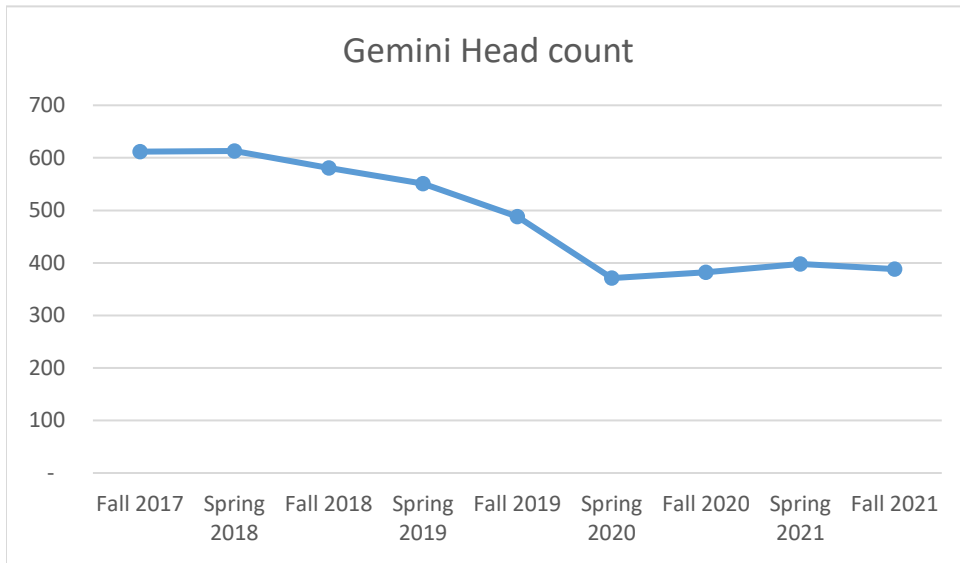
Adult Undergraduate Enrollment by Credit Hours



Graduate Enrollment by Credit Hours

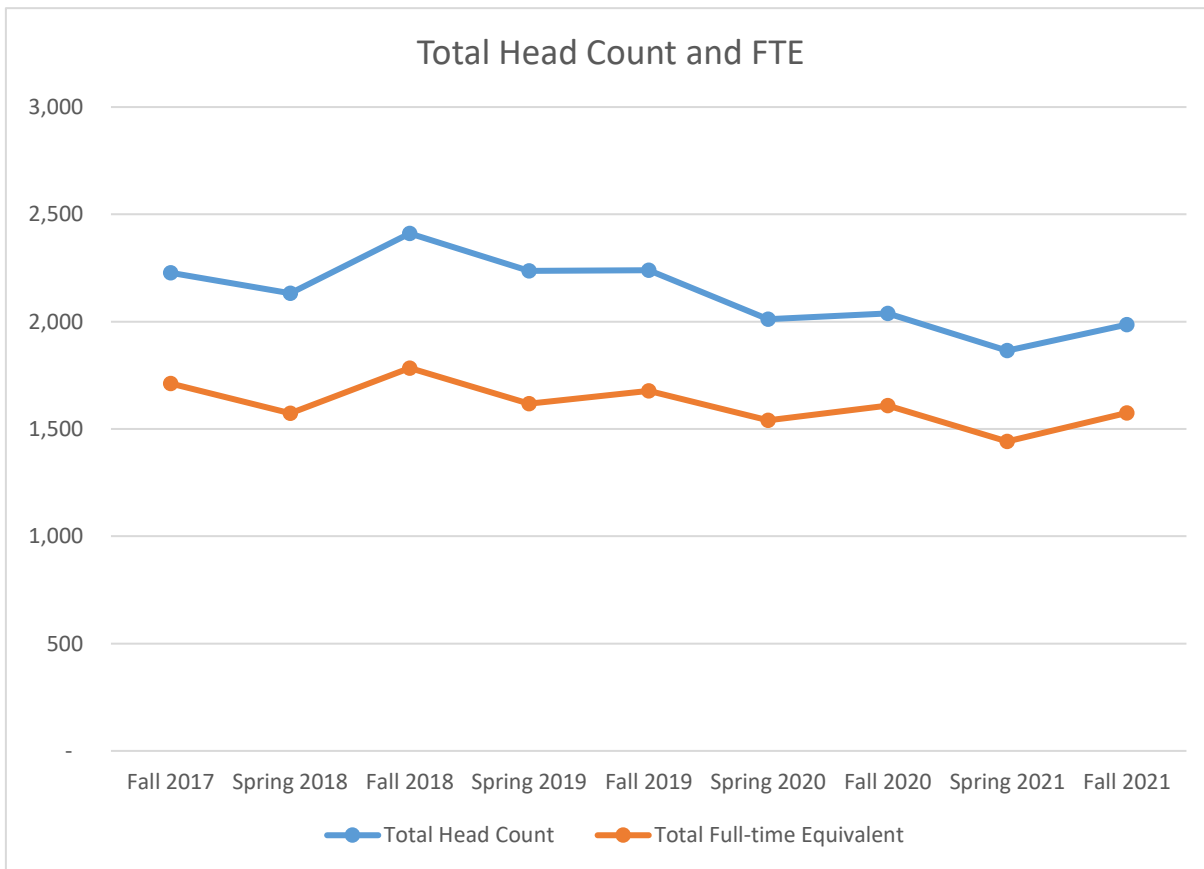
