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### Executive Summary


Full-time traditional enrollment is 1,116 students. 43 new students enrolled this spring. The persistence rate for returning students decreased 2 points from 88% to 86%. Traditional programs with the highest enrollment are Business, Nursing, and Biology. Adult and graduate enrollment is 312 students and 2,577 credit hours, which is consistent with budget projections. Dual credit enrollment is 398 students. Overall student head count is 1,865 students.







### Graduate Enrollment by Head count







