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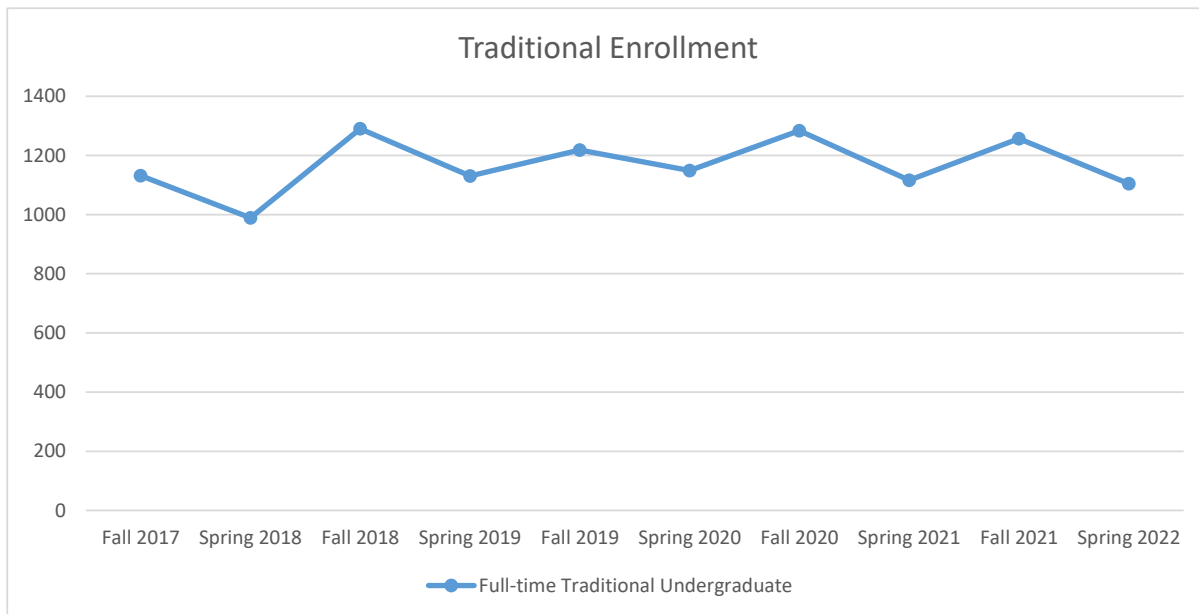
## Executive Summary

Full-time, traditional, undergraduate enrollment is just over 1,100 for the Spring 2022 semester. We had a small jump in fall to spring persistence from last academic year having 88.3% of our traditional undergraduate students return from the fall 2021. Digital, Graduate, and Professional enrollment numbers stayed about on level with previous academic year both in headcounts and in credit hours. The Gemini program did see a boost of almost 30 additional students from the fall (higher even than the previous two springs). Overall, the data are showing a maintenance of progress that still shows well as we continue to navigate all of the changes wrought by the pandemic.
