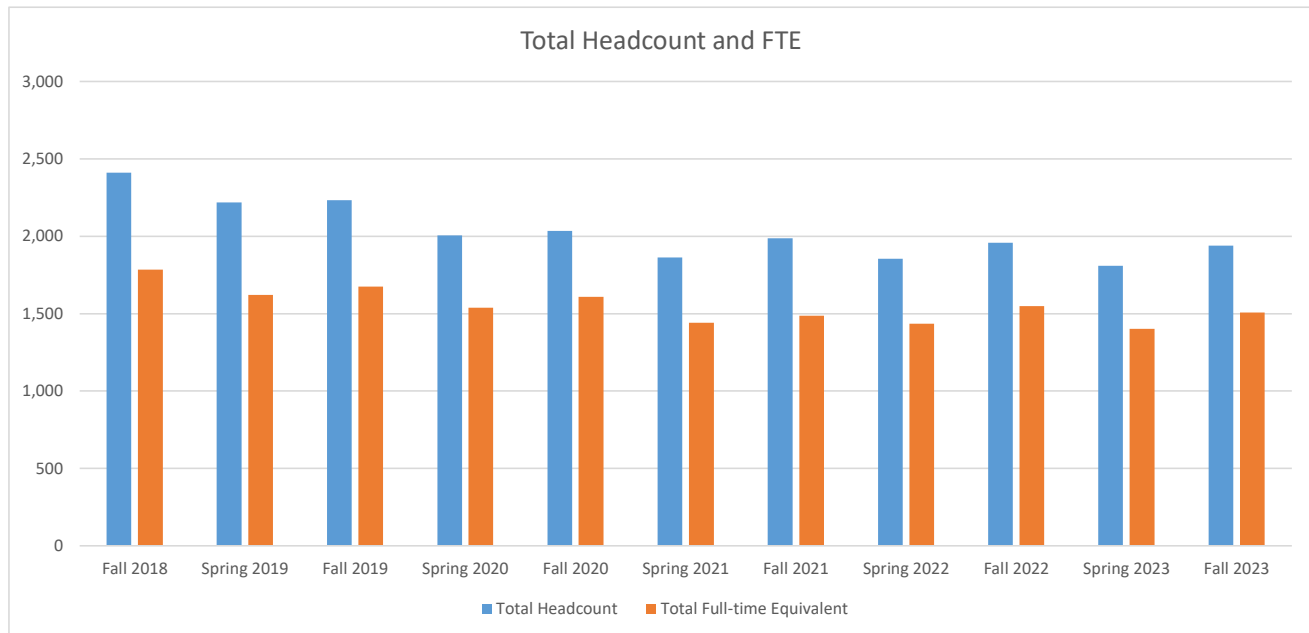
### Executive Summary

Thomas More University's official Fall Census is October 15.

Full-time, traditional enrollment is 1,214 students and total head count is 1,940. Spring to Fall persistence is 86% for traditional students, an improvement of 2%. The retention rate for the 2022 cohort is 66%, which is a slight improvement in our retention rate. There are 395 students in the 2023 first-time, full-time cohort. Accelerated & Graduate programs are enrolling 201 students with 1,628 credit hours. The count of students in the dual credit program is 512, up 26% since last fall. Resident enrollment is 468, the highest in University history.
