Jordan earned a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree with a minor in Psychology, maintained a 3.6 GPA and was named to the Dean's List seven times. In addition to her studies Jordan completed more than 500 clinical hours and worked part-time as a patient care assistant at Cincinnati Children's Hospital on the inpatient neuroscience and brain trauma unit. KENDRA YURT '24 & '26



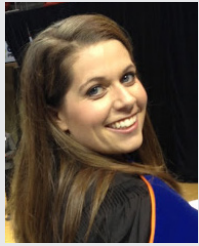

HISTORY OF THOMAS MORE UNIVERSITY

The Benedictine Sisters of Covington, KY, founded Villa Madonna College in 1921 to train Catholic school teachers and provide college education for young women. The school was chartered by the Commonwealth of Kentucky in 1923 and graduated its first students in 1929. Sponsorship changed from the Benedictine Sisters to the Diocese of Covington that same year.

Three religious orders operated Villa Madonna in its early years: the Sisters of Notre Dame, the Congregation of Divine Providence, and the Benedictine Sisters. Although founded as an institution for women, men attended many of the same classes through the affiliation between Villa Madonna and St. Thomas More College. In 1945, Villa Madonna was designated a co-educational college and St. Thomas More College was abolished.

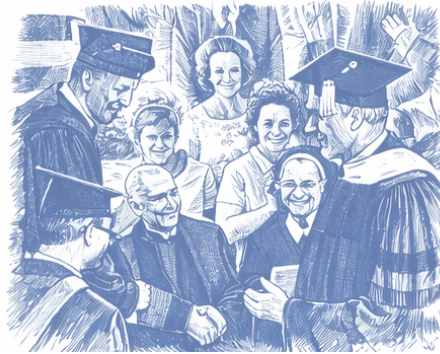
Affirmation of its goals and increasing enrollment prompted relocation of the college from downtown Covington to what is now Crestview Hills. The new complex was renamed Thomas More College and dedicated by President Lyndon B. Johnson in 1968.

In October of 2018, Thomas More officially became a university and restructured to host three distinct, autonomous colleges, in an effort to expand the institution's reach and present new academic opportunities.

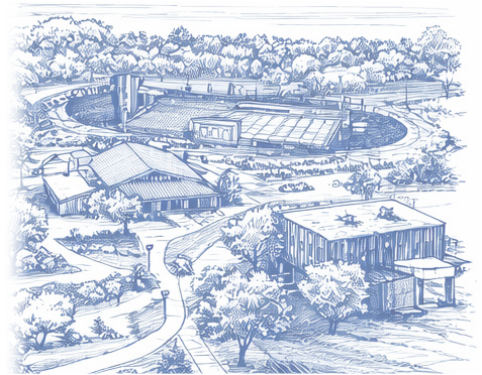

THOMAS MORE UNIVERSITY HONORARY DEGREE



Monsignor William (Bill) Cleves is the recipient of an honorary Doctor of Humane Letters degree.

Monsignor Cleves began his Thomas More career in 1983 as an instructor and was appointed Assistant Professor of Philosophy in 1986 and became Associate Professor of Philosophy in 1990. He also taught in the Languages Department, was the Faculty General Assembly president twice, and served as the college Chaplain from 1987-1992. In 1987, students selected Monsignor Cleves as the "Outstanding Full-time Teacher of the Year."

In 1992, Monsignor Cleves became the 11th president of the University and served in that role until 2001. During this period, President Cleves made several significant contributions to the University including:

- Expanding our International Outreach program welcoming students from Japan, Scotland, Germany, Ireland, and Puerto Rico.
- Launching the Thomas More Accelerated Program (TAP) for adult learners.
- Working with regional corporate and non-profit leaders to develop the Quest Program—a strategic vision for Northern Kentucky.
- Building of the football stadium and the Saints Center.
- The successful reaccreditation by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACSCOC).

In 2025, he was named President Emeritus by the Board of Trustees in honor of his leadership, service, and long history with the University.

Monsignor Cleves is currently a pastor at Holy Spirit Parish in Newport, KY and serves as a moderator and panelist of the William T. Robinson III Institute for Religious Liberty at Thomas More University.

CORE VALUES: CHARACTERISTICS OF A SAINT

Inspired by our patron, St. Thomas More, and the spirit of our three founding orders—the Benedictine Sisters, the Sisters of Notre Dame, and the Congregation of Divine Providence—we seek to live out in an intentional way the following characteristics as Thomas More Saints:

HOSPITALITY: God’s two greatest commandments are to love God and love others. To demonstrate love and care for others is a true sign of our love for God and our desire to live like Christ. Examining the ultimate meaning of life begins from an obedience to these two commandments to love. From that starting point, we live hospitality as an affirmation of each person’s intrinsic human dignity, welcoming all into our community and treating those who live, work, play, and grow with us “as Christ.” As the patron of the Benedictine Sisters, who hold hospitality paramount, St. Benedict instructed, “Let all guests who arrive be received as Christ.”

HUMILITY: Examining one’s place in the world requires humility: a recognition that each of us depend on each other and that our life is a journey to discover the Truth. Humility is a virtue that involves having a modest opinion of oneself, a sincere curiosity and openness to others, and recognizing God’s greatness. Our liberal arts educational framework within the Catholic Intellectual Tradition calls for the pursuit of Truth, which requires intellectual humility. Furthermore, an understanding of cultural humility is key to the tenets of the Catholic Social Teaching that invite us to work for the common good.

SERVICE: Examining one’s responsibility to others requires service. We are truly responsible to and for others when we care for each other’s needs. Serving one another is living out the mercy and love we first receive from God. In this way we grow in the awareness of the ethical dimension of our work and our lives, because we become more ourselves—more alive—the more we give of ourselves.

STEWARDSHIP: Being educated in the Catholic Intellectual Tradition is a transformative experience. The education Thomas More provides is not designed to inform, but to form. All aspects of our university are intentionally designed to help students discover their purpose, engage in their passions, and to then go out into the world as good stewards of their academic disciplines and personal vocations. A great Tradition and experience of learning is entrusted to all who participate in our university community, and each person is called to stewardship of what he or she has received, for the greater good of humanity, and in continual pursuit of what is True, Good, and Beautiful.



THE HISTORY OF ACADEMIC REGALIA

The ceremonial rituals of commencement can be traced back to medieval times and Europe’s first universities. Twelfth century scholars, typically clergy, wore long gowns and hoods, mainly for warmth. Academic gowns and hoods were adapted from these garments and continued to be modified throughout history. The academic attire worn in the United States dates back to colonial times, although the first academic costume code was developed in 1895 by the Intercollegiate Commission. It has remained the standard in the United States since, although each institution can make modifications.

The components of academic regalia are distinct by degree level. The tassel worn by graduates is typically black, although doctoral candidates wear gold tassels. For undergraduate students, the tassel is initially worn on the right side and moved to the left upon degree conferral. Master and doctoral students always wear the tassel on the right side. The gown is typically black. The bachelor’s gown has long, pointed sleeves. The master’s gown has oblong sleeves, closed at the end with a slit at the elbow for the arm. The doctoral robe is lined with velvet along the front and neck and has full, bell-shaped sleeves with three velvet bars at the top.

Students also wear a variety of cords, sashes, and medallions related to honorary and fraternal organizations.

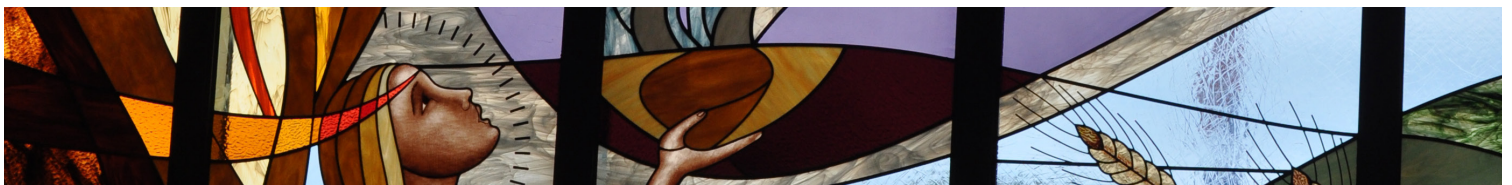
