

CIS/MIS Scholarship/Workship Terms & Conditions

The CIS/MIS Scholarship/Workship is a scholarship that covers the full cost of a student's tuition that is NOT covered by other scholarships. Non-Workship scholarships received by a Workship student are first applied to tuition (excepting those specifically designated for books, fees, room and board) and the CIS/MIS Scholarship/Workship will cover any remaining tuition costs.

The CIS/MIS Scholarship/Workship is a four-year scholarship renewable at the end of each academic year. Below are the participant requirements and expectations for the Scholarship/Workship to be renewed.

Academic Requirements

- 1. A minimum of a 2.75 GPA in all CIS/MIS courses
- 2. An overall 2.5 GPA in all courses
- 3. A minimum grade of C in all CIS/MIS courses
- 4. Progress towards completing a CIS/MIS degree within a four-year period of initial acceptance of the Scholarship/Workship. This includes taking CIS/MIS courses in the proper sequence at the proper time in the program.

Workship Expectations for the Scholarship

- 1. Work 20 hours per week
- 2. Work 52 weeks in a calendar year

Every Workship recipient must work 20 hours in a week. Various tasks include answering the phone, working directly with Faculty/Staff/Students on IT problems, working with printers, software and installing new hardware. No overtime is paid for any hours worked over 20 hours in a week.

Every Workship recipient must follow the policies and procedures outlined in the CIS/MIS Scholarship/Workship Policy Manual. The Scholarship/Workship may be terminated at the end of any semester if the student's performance is not satisfactory.
