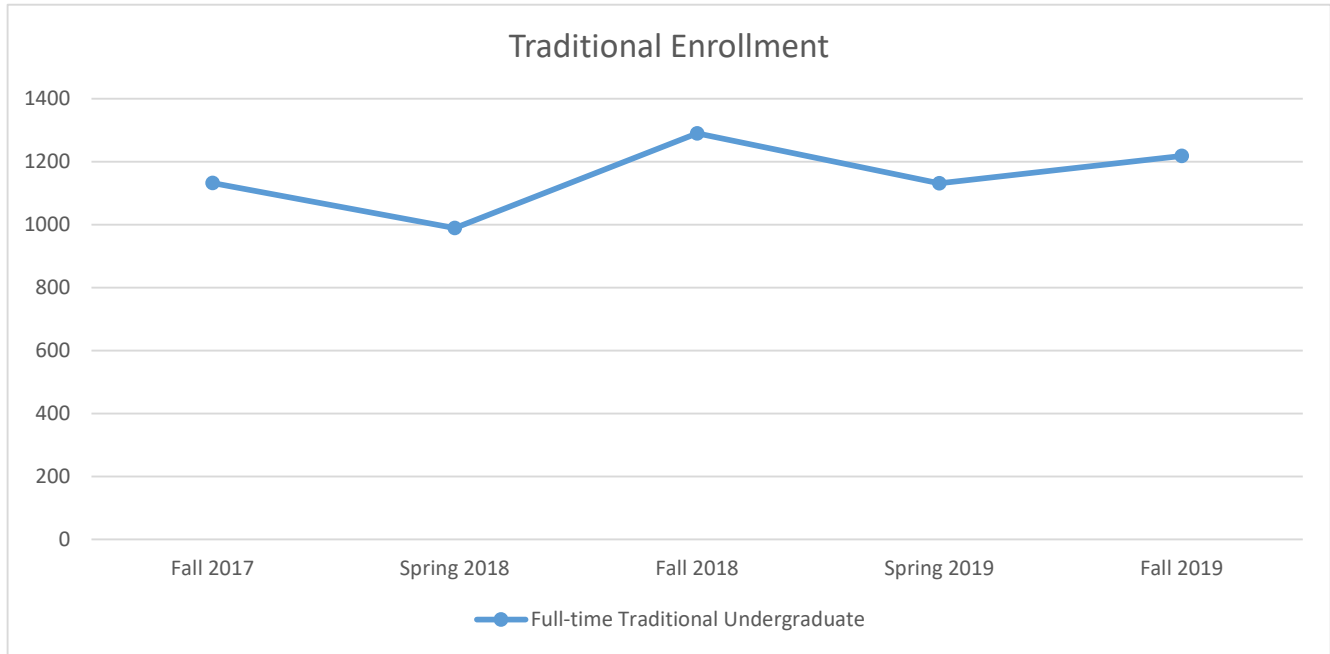
Executive Summary

Thomas More University has adjusted the official census date to October 15 in order to more accurately capture enrollment. Enrollment numbers throughout the data book are from the mid-semester October and March census in order to provide meaningful comparative data.

Overall student enrollment has decreased from last fall, from a total of 2,240 attending this fall compared to 2,411 last year. While enrollment is down from last year, the fall's enrollment continues to be one of the strongest in the last five years. Full-time traditional enrollment is 1,218 students, including 364 first-time cohort students. Traditional programs with the highest enrollment are Business, Biology, Nursing, and Education. Adult and graduate enrollment is 503 students, including 295 undergraduates and 208 graduates. While headcount is consistent with the prior fall, credit hours are up from 3,828 last fall to 4,012 this fall. Gemini enrollment is 488 students.

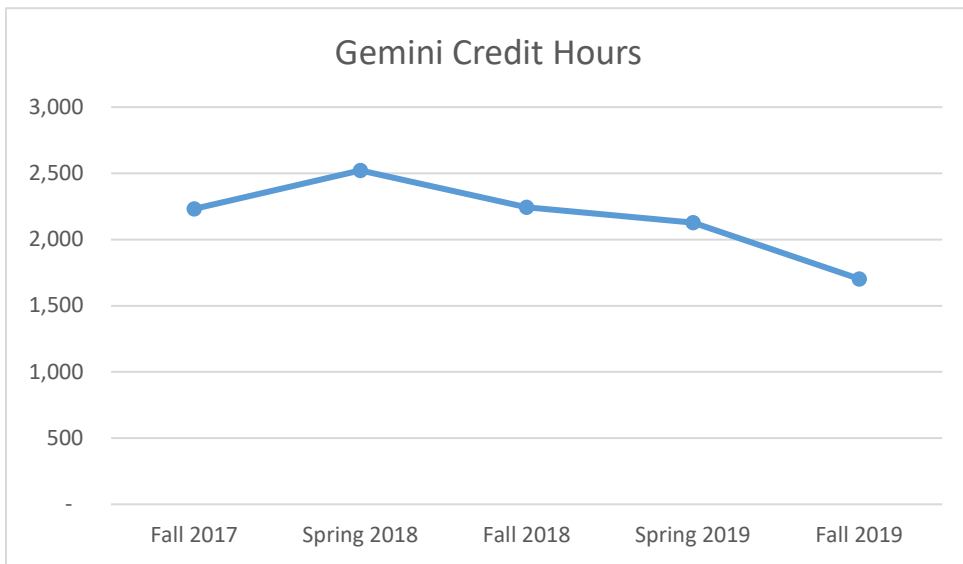
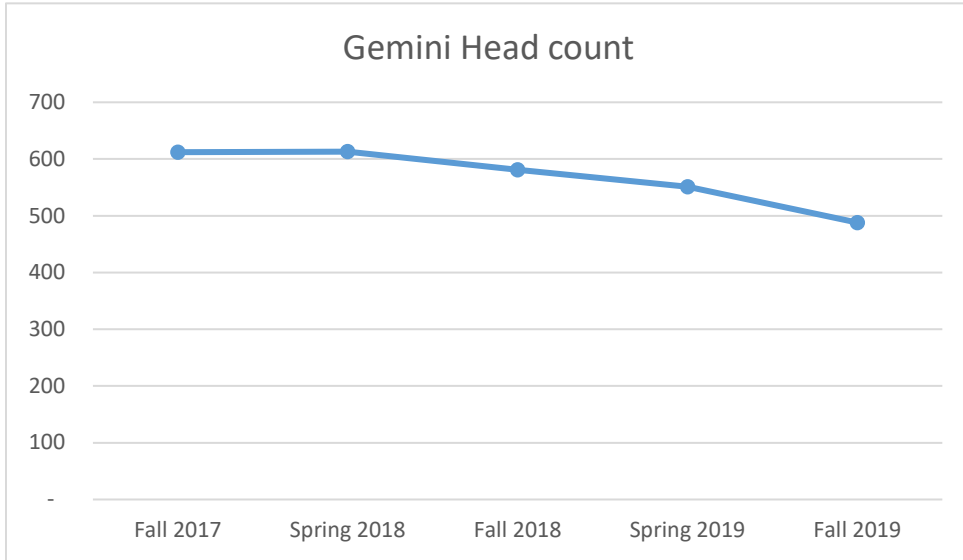


Adult and Graduate Enrollment by Program by Credit Hours

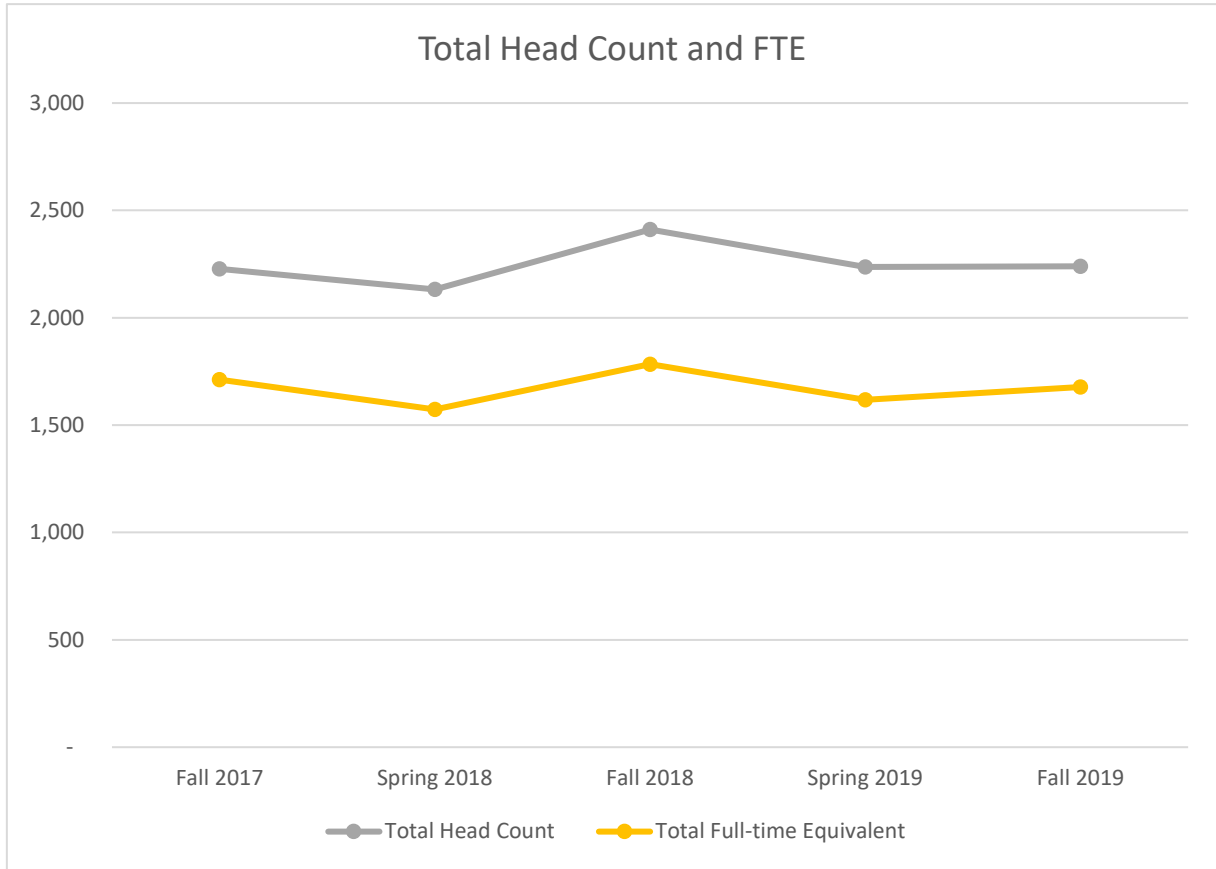
