
### **Executive Summary**

Full-time traditional enrollment is 1,149 students, our highest mid-semester traditional enrollment. 98 new students enrolled this spring, including 57 students from our teach-out agreement with Cincinnati Christian University. The persistence rate for returning students increased to 88.4% from 86.6% last spring. Traditional programs with the highest enrolled are Business, Biology, Nursing, and Education. Adult and graduate enrollment is 446 students (510 last year) and 3,599 credit hours (4,105 last year). The Bachelor of Elected Studies programs in Ethical Leadership and Individualized Program have grown significantly since last year. Dual credit enrollment is 371 (551 last year). Overall student head count is 2,011 students.
