Advising Codes

Many courses equate to a **specific course**. These are noted with a department code and course number (ex. ENG 150).

Others do not equate to a specific course, but fulfill an **advising requirement** (ex. FACORE).

There may also be courses that do not meet a specific advising requirement, but we will count the hours toward the completion of your degree. We call these **general electives** (GENELEC).

Transfer Status

Transfer completed – we have your final, official transcript, and you are enrolled.

Approved for transfer – we have your final, official transcript, and are just awaiting confirmation of your plan to transfer to complete the process.

Pending Official Transcript – we still need the official transcript. Please make sure the final transcript is sent to us.

Your report shows which classes transfer to Thomas More and how they count.

Classes that don't transfer will not be listed. If you have received credit via AP tests, that will be added once we receive a copy of your scores from College Board.

If you wish to seek a re-evaluation you may request a re-evaluation via the form on the transfer webpage.

Important Things to Know:

- Which credits transfer? Classes must have a grade of C- or higher.
- How we decide: Our Registrar and academic departments review your classes.
- GPAs from other schools do not transfer. You'll start with a new GPA after your first semester here.
- Pass/Satisfactory classes usually transfer only as general electives.
