What do I do if I test positive for COVID-19?

Please follow the CDC guidelines on isolation at:

https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/your-health/isolation.html.

When your isolation period ends, please continue to wear a mask for an additional 5 days. Do not return to campus with a fever. You must be fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications.

Individuals are expected to seek medical advice, follow guidelines for quarantine, and inform their close contacts. If you are living on campus, please go home for your isolation period. If you are not able to go home isolate yourself in your room. You may go to the cafeteria to get meals but please wear a mask and social distance.

Employees are expected to notify their supervisors of any COVID-19 related absences and may work from home if possible. Students are expected to work with their faculty members to make up for any missed assignments and may reach out to their advisor for support.
